30 Purpose of grant or amendment

Public law 116-20 has appropriated \$50 million from the Historic Preservation Fund to provide relief to historic resources located with the major disaster declarations pursuant to the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act (42 USC 5121 et seq.) for Hurricanes Florence, Michael, and Typhoon Yutu. Counties in North Carolina that received a FEMA disaster declaration during Hurricanes Florence or Michael are eligible for aid through subgrants. Allowable costs include program areas as defined by the National Historic Preservation Act (Administration, Development, National Register, Planning, Survey and Inventory, Review and Compliance). Recovery and repair of historic properties in areas that received a major disaster declaration.
