The NC Office of State Budget and Management (OSBM) is committed to serving North Carolinians by providing objective information and analysis to ensure a balanced budget and effective stewardship of public resources.

North Carolina Opioid Settlement

In July 2021, NC Attorney General Josh Stein announced a historic \$26 billion agreement that will help bring relief to communities impacted by opioids. The agreement resolves litigation over the role of four companies in creating and fueling the opioid epidemic and requires significant industry changes to help prevent this type of crisis from happening again. Settlement funds will be used to support treatment, recovery, harm reduction, and other life-saving programs and services in communities across NC.
