Federal Buckets of Funding

There are hundreds of millions of dollars in <u>Annual Appropriations</u> for federal competitive grants to state and local governments, and even more recently through special legislation.



- American Rescue Plan
 - State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds the exception, not the rule
- Bipartisan Infrastructure Law
- Inflation Reduction Act





Counties: The Big Picture

County statutory roles are "human centered" – health, welfare, education Carry out state responsibilities at the local level

Little overlap between municipal and county services but much collaboration

What Counties Do Roughly 80% of County resources are spent here

Health and Human Services

Public Safety

Public Health – COVID, Medicaid, Immunizations, Mental Health






Connecting to County Government

Most roads go through the County Manager – a County's CEO


In larger counties, a deputy/assistant manager or department head can also be a good place to start



How to learn more about a County

County Strategic Plan	Articulates County's priorities and strategies for meeting community needs within areas of responsibility
Annual Budget	Resource allocation plan that aligns with County goals and priorities to deliver services
Annual Comprehensive Financial Report	Summary of all fiscal activities, MD&A, including a Schedule of Federal and State Funding
Community Health Needs Assessment	Collaborative Community-wide process completed every three years to assess health needs of the County






Elected officials with administrative functions

Budget & Fiscal Control Act



- Found in <u>Chapter 159</u> in NC General Statutes
- Local governments must:
 - Produce a **budget ordinance** covering July 1 to June 30
 - Receive **budget requests** from departments before April 30
 - Provide budget for inspection and **public hearing**
 - Provide a **budget message** containing explanations of...
 - Goals and important activities
 - Reasons for changes in policies, funding, etc.

GFOA Distinguished Budget Presentation Award

- Established in 1984
- Budget docs of "the very highest quality" which excel as a...
 - Policy Document
 - Financial Plan
 - Operations Guide
 - $\circ~$ Communication Tool
- 61 awarded in NC as of 2021

- Strategic Goals and Strategies
- Priorities and Issues
- Budget Process
- Revenues
- Department / Program Descriptions
- Departmental / Program Goals and Objectives
- Performance Measures

Where to find budget info?

- Google / search for your community's budget department or budget document
- When in doubt, contact the Finance Director or Manager (or Clerk in *very small* communities)
- If no "budget book" available, you can ask for the budget ordinance
- For partnerships, aim for the closest department that does what you do and go from there
- <u>NCLM Budget Dashboard</u> for some high level info


