SUBJECT: **OSBM State Technical Assistance and Match Program (STAMP) - Technical Assistance Application Guidelines**

As described in the [OSBM memorandum sent October 16th](#), OSBM launched the State Technical Assistance and Match Program (STAMP) to help state agencies apply for and win Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL), Chips and Science Act (CHIPS), and Inflation Reduction Act (IRA) funding.

OSBM will now accept applications for the following types of STAMP Technical Assistance (STAMP-TA):

- (1) In-house Support (i.e., funds for your agency to hire time-limited positions or third-party contractors to support applying for a grant), or
- (2) OSBM-provided Support (i.e., direct support from a consulting team hired to provide technical assistance statewide).

I encourage you and your team to review our [STAMP Technical Assistance Application Guidelines](#), providing details on the program's purpose, eligibility, and application submission and awards processes. A total of \$5 million is available for technical assistance. Guidance on applying for matching funds is expected to be released in early 2024.
