SUBJECT: Increase to Cost of State Capital Projects

Pursuant to G.S. 143C-8-8, a State Agency may increase the cost of a capital project with gifts, federal or private grants, special fund receipts, or direct capital improvement appropriations if it is in the best interest of the State. The Department of Natural and Cultural Resources requested increases to five projects that have exceeded or are projected to exceed their original budget due to unexpected costs. The approved projects and their revenue sources are listed below.
