30 Purpose of grant or amendment	The Child Mental Health Team of the Division of MH/DD/SAS is applying for a Duke Endowment Grant entitled Child and Family Well-Being Grant. The Duke Endowment is a philanthropic/non-governmental organization who provides grant money to expand opportunities to vulnerable children. We have submitted a proposal for \$2,769,000 over a three-year period. Awardee announcements were made by 57/2021. The Division of MH/DD/SAS was awarded the grant for the MORES project for \$2,769,000 over a 3-year period. This grant will help us contract out for a time-limited MORES Project Director through the University of North Carolina, Greensboro, who will lead the MORES pilot project. This is an enhanced mobile intervention targeting children ages 3-21 and their families who are experiencing escalating emotional or behavioral symptoms or traumatic circumstances which havecompromised the youth's ability to function at their baseline within their family, living situation, school and/or community environments. This program will support the enhancement of the current mobile crisis response to be more youth and family focused in meeting behavioral health crisis needs. Start-up costs will enhance five existing mobile crisis teams and coverage of up to 10 counties. DMHDDSAS will be working with the LME-MCOs to select the counties (a mixture of rural and urban) for the pilot project. The enhancements are added to exsiting mobile crisis teams and include: 1. 1 FTE Project Director (time-limited position - not a state position) 2. 1 FTE Licensed Child-Focused Clinician per team (Provider position and not a state position) 3. 1 FTE Family Peer Partner (per team) to promote engagement and family voice and choice (Provider position and not a state position) 4. Training for each team 5. 30-60 Minute response time (down from current 2 hour expected response time) 6. Provision of stabilization services up to 4 weeks post crisis (as needed) to ensure children are connected to behavioral health services 7. Assessment of parent/caregiver beh

THE DUKE ENDOWMENT

Grant Agreement **21-11-SGO**May 4, 2021

To:

The Duke Endowment (the "Endowment") hereby agrees, in consideration of the covenants and agreements contained herein, to provide grant funds to N.C. Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities and Substance Abuse Services (the "Grantee") as follows:

Purpose:

To pilot enhanced mobile crisis response to address behavioral health

needs of children.

Amount Approved:

\$2,769,000

Grant Payment:

\$923,000 payable within sixty days after this Agreement has been fully executed, with the balance of \$1,846,000 payable in increments through April 30, 2024, and in the sole and absolute discretion of the Endowment.

General Conditions:

This Agreement expressly incorporates herein all of the terms, conditions, covenants and agreements contained in the General Terms and Conditions for Grants Made by The Duke Endowment, effective November 6, 2007 (the "General Terms and Conditions"), and Grantee agrees to abide by all such terms, conditions, covenants and agreements as if they were fully set forth herein.

Special Conditions:

- 1. Grantee hereby certifies to the Endowment (a) that the factual statements contained in the documents submitted by Grantee during the grant application process, including without limitation the budget for the project or purpose described therein, all of which are hereby incorporated by reference, are true, accurate and complete and may be relied upon by the Endowment in making this grant to Grantee, and (b) that Grantee has received a copy of the General Terms and Conditions.
- 2. Reports on the progress of the grant's outcomes and its expenditures will be made by the Grantee to the Endowment upon request in accordance with paragraph 5 of the General Terms and Conditions.
- 3. The balance of all funds necessary to achieve the project at its proposed scale and scope is available, and the Grantee is committed to covering budget shortfalls resulting from operations.
- 4. Grantee certifies, in writing, that project staff for enhanced mobile crisis teams have been hired

This Agreement is to be signed by the President or other executive officer of Grantee expressly authorized by Grantee's governing body to execute such agreements. The signature of such officer will indicate acceptance by Grantee of all the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement and in the General Terms and Conditions.
