SUBJECT: State Capital and Infrastructure Funds Report

Attached is the report required by G.S. 143C-8-14 regarding the status of State Agency projects funded by the State Capital and Infrastructure Funds. This report reflects projects funded directly by the General Assembly within various Appropriations Acts and currently does not reflect the project status from funding from for Repairs and Renovations. Our office is currently working to compile the Repairs and Renovations Report for State Agencies. State Agency project amounts may differ from amounts appropriated by the General Assembly. There are two reasons for this difference:

- 1) Repairs and Renovations funds may have been used to supplement projects if allowable under G.S. 143C-8-13.
- 2) Office of State Budget and Management Flexibility Funds may have been to supplement projects up to the allowable ten percent (10%) of project authorization.
