

Office of State Budget and Management

- LINC Login to North Carolina
 - Log Into North Carolina (LINC) is your best first stop for information about North Carolina. LINC is a data retrieval service, drawing together data produced across state government for a variety of geographic areas. Topics include population and housing, employment and income, education, transportation, agriculture, environment, vital statistics, social services, energy & utilities, criminal justice, and more.

Department of Commerce

- Labor Market Data & Tools
 - The Labor and Economic Analysis Division of N.C. Commerce provides state and regional labor market data analysis so that communities, businesses, site selectors, and investors can make informed decisions in their fields. Data includes labor market publications, employment projections, and education and workforce program outcomes.
- <u>NC Tower</u>
 - NC Tower is an online reporting tool using data in the common follow-up system (CFS) to provide aggregate information on education and employment outcomes for students who attend North Carolina public universities, high schools, and community colleges.

Department of Environmental Quality

- DEQ Online GIS
 - A platform for exploring DEQ's environmental and regulatory data for a variety of geographies across air, water, and land. Topics include: permitting, monitoring, and mitigation data; species and habitat assessments; geology, infrastructure, waste management, and more.
- DEQ NC Community Mapping System and Environmental Justice Tool
 - Provides communities with permitting and other environmental information to inform local outreach and public participation. DEQ has developed the Environmental Justice Tool within the NCCMS to provide relevant demographic and health data.

Department of Health and Human Services

- <u>NC Medicaid Enrollment Overview</u>
 - NC Medicaid Enrollment Overview contains dashboards that display information on program metrics and key performance indicators (KPI). These Dashboards include data related to enrollment, claims monitoring, annual reports, and payments to providers.
- <u>State Center for Health Statistics</u>
 - <u>Statistics and Reports</u> on a wide range of topics including: births, deaths, accidents, disease, infant and maternal health, health risk behaviors surveys, social determinants of health, and health care.

- <u>North Carolina Health Data Query System</u> Interactive database system that provides customized reports of health data based on user-specified selection of variables (e.g. age, race, county)
- The <u>NC Health Atlas</u> contains maps for North Carolina that depict county level health and health related information. Maps data include social determinants of health, vital statistics, cancer incidence and mortality, communicable diseases, and more.
- Early Childhood Data
 - The Department of Health and Human Services provides a variety of dashboards and data sources that contain information items related to children ages birth to age eight.
- Sheps Health Workforce NC Sheps Center
 - <u>Hospital and Health Services Data</u>: The Sheps Center stores and manages various data resources for use in health services research. There are varying rules for who can use these data, and how they can be accessed. See website for details about the particular dataset of interest.
 - <u>Health Workforce</u>: Interactive data visualization dashboards of North Carolina's supply of health professionals. Users may also download county level data and view statistic reports.
- The North Carolina Disease Event Tracking and Epidemiologic Collection Tool (NC DETECT)
 - NC DETECT is North Carolina's statewide syndromic surveillance system. Authorized users can view data from emergency departments, North Carolina Poison Control, and emergency medical services (EMS), as well as pilot data from select urgent care centers.

Department of Information Technology

- <u>NC OneMap</u>
 - NC OneMap is a strategic resource providing a collection of authoritative data and web services. It is an organized effort of numerous partners throughout North Carolina, involving local, state, and federal government agencies, the private sector and academia.

Department of Natural and Cultural Resources

- NC Natural Heritage Program Data
 - The North Carolina Natural Heritage Program provides a databased or natural resource information by combining on-the-ground surveys with advanced GPS and GIS technology.

Department of Public Instruction

- Education Data and Reports
 - The Department of Public Instruction provides a variety of data sets and reports on issues related to education. These include school report cards, testing results, and graduation rates.

- <u>School Accountability and Reporting</u>
 - Provides reports on issues related to K-12 accountability including ACT/SAT reports, federal reports, and cohort graduation rates

Department of Public Safety

- Justice Data Portal at the Criminal Justice Analysis Center
 - The Justice Data Portal contains centralized criminal justice data and statistics collected by agencies across the state. It is run by the Criminal Justice Analysis Center which is part of the Governor's Crime Commission.
- Emergency Management: FIMAN Flood Mapping Inundation Network
 - FIMAN provides rain and stage gate data, flood inundation maps, flooding impacts and alerts in real-time to support risk-based decisions regarding flooding.
- North Carolina Flood Risk Information System
 - The Flood Risk Information System (FRIS) contains flood hazard data, models, maps, risk assessments and reports.

Department of Transportation

- <u>NCDOT GO!NC Portal</u>
 - GO! NC is the North Carolina Department of Transportation's portal through which NCDOT staff, business partners, and others can access and publish geospatial information pertaining to transportation in North Carolina.
- <u>ConnectNCDOT</u>
 - Through its business resource site, DOT makes traffic, infrastructure, and environmental data, reports, and maps available for download.

North Carolina Community Colleges

- <u>NC Community Colleges Dashboards</u>
 - The NC Community Colleges System provides several interactive dashboards related to education themes including high school dual enrollment, transfer and employment outcomes, and state performance measures.

North Carolina Judicial Branch

- <u>Court Data Dashboard</u>
 - Provides trial court case statistics and visualizations at the state and county level.
- Judicial Publications and Reports
 - The Judicial branch produces numerous publications to inform stakeholders and the public on various court-related matters. Reports include school-based complaints, impaired driving charges, foreclosure filings, and more.
