30 Purpose of grant or amendment

FFPSA Transition Grants may be used for any purpose specified in title IV-B of the Act, the portions of the Act authorizing the Stephanie Tubbs Jones Child Welfare Services Program (title IV-B, subpart 1) and the Mary Lee Allen Promoting Safe and Stable Families Program (title IV-B, subpart 2). Funds may also be used for activities directly associated with the implementation of FFPSA. In addition, for jurisdictions that previously operated title IV-E child welfare waiver demonstration projects under the authority of section 1130 of the Act, the FFPSA Transition Grants may be used for activities previously funded under such projects to reduce any adverse fiscal impacts associated with the end of the waiver demonstration projects and the transitioning of project activities to other funding sources. The FFPSA Transition Grants will be awarded in fiscal year (FY) 2020, but will remain available to grantees for expenditure through the end of FY 2025.
